“To Do” List:

1. Read ALL of the confirmation material carefully.
2. Complete the Medical Form & have your signature notarized.
3. Fill out the Camper Release. Print neatly, please!
4. **EXPRESS CHECK-IN:** We must receive the Medical Form already notarized, the Camper Release and final payment including “bank money” **at least one full week before** your week of camp. The suggested amount of bank money is \$30.
5. If necessary, you may bring all of the above mentioned items with you to participate in the regular registration line.

General Information:

- The camp fee covers meals, crafts, activities, a camp t-shirt and a keepsake DVD of your week of camp.
- Acceptance & participation in camp are the same for everyone regardless of race, color or national origin.
- Phone calls to & from home are ONLY allowed in the case of an emergency. Camper mail is encouraged!
- ALL visitors must check in with the Camp Director IMMEDIATELY upon arrival.
- We reserve the right to send anyone home (without a refund) for unacceptable behavior or for bringing unacceptable items. See the “Do Not Bring” list on the following page.
- **Check-In begins at 4:00 p.m. on Sunday.** Please do not arrive early— gate will be locked until 3:45. **Your child must be present in the registration line.** Please allow time for making the transition to camp an enjoyable experience!
- There will be a closing program on Friday from 4:00 - 4:45 p.m. Parents, please plan to attend!

Children doing MailBox Club or Correspondence lessons will receive a scholarship award notice at the end of the school year. Note: If you pay in full in advance of this, to qualify for Express Check-In, the scholarship money will be added to your child’s “bank money”.

“Bank Money” is in addition to the camp fee and is used by your child for **snacks** and **souvenirs** at the Snack Shack and for the **missions offering**. Any amount can be put in the “bank” but the suggested amount is \$30. Your child will be encouraged to give generously to the missions offering but any money not spent will be returned on Friday.

What to Pack:

- Bible, notebook and pen
- pillow, sheets & blanket or sleeping bag
- towels for swimming and showering
- play clothes: modest shorts, t-shirts, jeans, etc.
- modest one-piece swimsuit
- pajamas, underwear, socks
- light jacket or sweater
- tennis shoes and flip-flops
- toiletries: toothbrush, soap, insect repellent, sun screen, etc.
- optional: disposable camera, flashlight



Do Not Bring:

- cell phones
- radios, MP3/CD players, magazines
- illegal drugs, alcohol or cigarettes
- knives, weapons, fireworks
- electronic games or valuables

If you choose to bring the items listed above, you risk being sent home without a refund.

➡ **ALL money must be turned in to the “bank” at registration!** Camp Grace is NOT responsible for money kept in the cabin. The Snack Shack uses the “bank system” and does not accept cash.

➡ **ALL medication must be turned in to the camp nurse at registration!**

This includes over-the-counter & non-prescription medication, too! Bring current medication in its original container with instructions. Asthma inhalers are allowed in the cabin upon approval from the camp nurse.

Dress Code

The purpose of the dress code is to help maintain the intended atmosphere at Camp Grace.
We reserve the right to ask anyone to change if deemed necessary by the camp staff.

- Shirts: No inappropriate slogans. No cleavage, bra-straps, or tummies showing.
- Shorts: They should fall at least halfway between hipbone & knee. No writing on the seat!
- Jeans: No writing on the seat or inappropriate holes or tears.
- No undergarments showing at any time!
- Modest, one-piece swimsuit (A dark cover-up must be worn over two-piece suits as well as inappropriate one-piece suits.)

Helpful Hints

- ▶ Leave CELL PHONES at home!
- ▶ Label personal belongings with your name or initials.
- ▶ Pack a trash bag or extra pillow case to put dirty clothes in.
- ▶ Pack a pre-addressed, pre-stamped envelope and paper so your child can send you a letter.
- ▶ Parents, please send mail but. . . **Keep the message positive!** (See note about HOMESICKNESS.)

DIRECTIONS: Take I-95 to Exit 7 (Raynham Rd.) turn East toward McDonald & Fairmont. Stay on Raynham Road for 4.5 miles. Turn Right onto Grace Drive. Follow signs into the “heart” of camp.

Sunday afternoon registration:

1. Your **child must be present** in the registration line or you will be asked to go to the end of the line!
2. **ALL money and medication** must be turned in at this time!
3. Bring medication and a completed Medication Registration form in a gallon-size storage bag labeled with your child's name.
4. **After registration, you may go with your child to meet the cabin leaders.**
5. Optional: Surprise gift bags can be purchased at the Snack Shack before you head home.

Want to avoid HOMESICKNESS?

You play an important role in helping your child have a successful summer camp experience. While preparing for camp, it is important to watch what you say and how you act. Expressing your excitement about the upcoming opportunity to make new friends and telling your child that you are proud of him/her for wanting to attend summer camp will help ease apprehensions.

Assure your child that the camp staff will take good care of him/her. **Don't promise to take your child home if he/she wants to go home. A bit of homesickness is normal and is often easily remedied by a caring cabin leader.** Recovering from homesickness without being "rescued" usually brings about a new sense of pride and self-confidence. **We will call you if we believe it best for your child to go home.**

Send mail — but don't express feelings of sadness about your child not being at home; instead, mention that you look forward to hearing all about the camp experience.

The emotional health of every camper is important to us so we ask that parents don't visit camp during the week. Interrupting the camp schedule can cause homesickness and might even affect someone else's child. Together we can help every child accomplish something very special — **a week of personal growth and fun at summer camp!**

EXPRESS CHECK-IN

We must receive these items from you **at least one full week before** your child's week of camp:

- Registration Form
- Notarized Medical Form
- Camper Release Who might be picking up your child?
- Total Camp Fee (\$195 Overnight / \$110 Day Camp + transportation fee if applicable)
- Bank Money The suggested amount for overnight campers is \$30. Bank Money is optional for day campers since snacks are included in the price of day camp and you will be notified about bringing money for Store Day.
