

What to Pack:

- Bible, notebook and pen
- pillow, sheets & blanket or sleeping bag
- towels for swimming and showering
- play clothes: modest shorts, t-shirts, jeans, etc.
- modest one-piece swimsuit
- pajamas, underwear, socks
- light jacket or sweater
- tennis shoes and flip-flops
- toiletries: toothbrush, soap, insect repellent, sun screen, etc.
- optional: disposable camera, flashlight



Do Not Bring:

- cell phones
- radios, MP3/CD players, magazines
- illegal drugs, alcohol or cigarettes
- knives, weapons, fireworks
- Electronic Games or Valuables

Warning: We reserve the right to send anyone home (without a refund) for bringing unacceptable items.

- ⇒ There is NO “bank” system at a retreat. The recommended amount of spending money for the Snack Shack is \$5. You are responsible for your own spending money.
- ⇒ ALL medication (including OTC’s) must be turned in to the camp nurse at registration. Bring current medication in its original container with instructions. Asthma inhalers are allowed in the cabin after approval from the camp nurse.

Dress Code

The purpose of the dress code is to help maintain the intended atmosphere at Camp Grace.
We reserve the right to ask anyone to change if deemed necessary by the camp staff.

- Shirts: No inappropriate slogans. No cleavage, bra-straps, or tummies showing.
- Shorts: They should fall at least halfway between hipbone & knee. No writing on the seat!
- Jeans: No writing on the seat or inappropriate holes or tears.
- No undergarments showing at any time!
- Modest, **one-piece** swimsuit (A dark cover-up must be worn over two-piece suits as well as inappropriate one-piece suits.)

- ⇒ Leave CELL PHONES at home!
- ⇒ Label your things with your name or initials.
- ⇒ Pack a trash bag or extra pillow case to put dirty clothes in.
